CO₂ Solutions to Address International Coal Power Conference

Presentation offers the opportunity to highlight the Company's breakthrough technology to coal-fired power industry for efficiently reducing carbon emissions

(“the Company”) (TSX-V: CST), the leader in enzyme-enabled carbon dioxide (CO₂) capture announced today it will make a presentation on June 2, 2015 at the Clearwater Clean Coal Conference in Clearwater, Florida. Mr. Jonathan Carley, CO₂ Solutions’ Vice-President of Business Development will present recent developments relating to the commercialization of the Company’s low-cost and environmentally friendly technology for addressing carbon emissions from coal-fired power plants. Mr. Carley was invited to speak at the conference by the Government of Canada, in support of innovative Canadian clean energy technologies.

According to the International Energy Agency (IEA) GHG Program, there are more than 2,000 coal-fired power plants worldwide with combined emissions of 8.8 billion tonnes of CO₂ annually. This represents approximately one-third of all manmade carbon emissions. Accordingly, reducing emissions from this sector has been widely deemed essential in efforts to combat climate change.

As announced on April 29, 2015, CO₂ Solutions’ carbon capture technology was shown to have a cost below the U.S. Department of Energy’s year 2025 target for new carbon capture processes, ten years ahead of schedule. This is based on the Company’s breakthrough approach which uses low-grade, nil value heat and dramatically reduces the impact of the carbon capture process on the power plant’s output. As such, the Company’s technology provides a cost-effective, near-term option as part of a carbon capture, utilization and sequestration approach to achieving large reductions in CO₂ emissions from power generation and other industrial sectors in North America and globally.

“We are witnessing strong momentum towards a global agreement on emissions reductions leading up to the United Nations Climate Change Conference later this year”, said Mr. Carley. “Reducing emissions from the power sector will be essential to this effort, and our technology is a cost-effective means of doing so. We are very pleased to have the opportunity to present this value proposition to this significant audience.”

The Clearwater Clean Coal Conference has earned a reputation as one of the premiere conferences on coal technologies since 1975.
